Construction Begins....

Through consultations with another local NGO that manages their own primary school for hearing children, the Buea School for the Deaf came in contact with a builder, carpenter and electrician to begin construction of its new school buildings on 11th of June 2010

Prior to this date, the school had obtained a building permit, cleared the site and built a working well to ensure adequate water source for the construction of the classrooms.

Currently nearing completion is a block of three classrooms, and flush-water system toilet facilities. While the South-West Region has entered the rainy season which has slowed down work, the builder is confident of completing the next block (four classrooms and toilet facilities) by mid September.

During the school holidays, 5 BSD students have been working with the building crew and gaining valuable work experience.

Plea for Assistance to Build the New School...


To make the transition a smooth one, we need to construct 13 classrooms, 4 toilet facilities, and an administrative block. We also need to bring in electricity and water.
